Seven anti-ICE demonstrators in Texas have been sentenced to 50-100 years in prison for a detention center protest in 2025 and one community member has been sentenced to **30 years** for moving a box of personal belongings that included anarchist zines. The defendants have been subjected to horrific conditions in prison: daily strip searches, solitary confinement, lack of access to medical care. We need your help resisting these sentences before this repression becomes the new normal and so that we can bring these parents, community members, and loved ones home.

The charges stem from activities many of us have taken part in since ICE started terrorizing our communities: attending a demonstration, moving a box of zines, removing someone who's been arrested from a Signal chat. The case is a testing ground for a new level of repression that criminalizes dissent.
